

# WHY ADOPTION






We have always felt we were destined to be parents, and this is the path that was chosen for us.

Family and friends are so important to us, and we value the sense of community that they bring to our lives. Life is better with loved ones by your side, and we're always trying to welcome others into our house.




#### Perseverance

#### NICOLE'S FAMILY


