


DEAR EXPECTANT PARENTS,





We are best friends. We love hanging out with our boys, being outside, traveling, spending time with our friends and family, and our church community. We make a great team because we balance each other out.






"Meet" COLIN


I love to snowboard, be outside, work on building projects, and help coach Owen's baseball team.
































Coling



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


